Florida Community College at Jacksonville Computing Facilities Policies and User Agreement

Florida community College at Jacksonville (FCCJ) computing facilities are defined as any computer, network, peripheral, operating system, software, or any combination thereof owned, licensed by or under the control of Florida Community College at Jacksonville.

A user of FCCJ Computing Facilities will:

Recognize that FCCJ computing facilities are intended to support the academic mission and administrative functions of the college and assume full responsibility for using these facilities in an effective, efficient, ethical, lawful and courteous manner.

 \mathbf{K} ecognize that authorized FCCJ systems personnel may, while performing routine operations or investigating system problems or complaints, have access to data and software stored in FCCJ computing facilities, including electronic mail.

Recognize that FCCJ disclaims responsibility for loss of data, time delay, system performance, software performance or any other damages arising from the use of FCCJ computing facilities.

Understand that some systems at FCCJ are operated under license agreements with IBM, Microsoft, Novell and others. Under these agreements, the systems may be used for instructional and research-related purposes only.

 \mathbf{T} ake all necessary steps to protect the integrity of FCCJ computing facilities. Specifically, users shall not share with others the access codes, account numbers, passwords or other authorization assigned to them. The user shall be responsible for all access and/or authorizations assigned and all activities occurring under these accesses/authorizations.

Kespect the copyrights of all software and data available through FCCJ computing facilities. Take reasonable steps to protect the integrity and privacy of the software and data available.

Use FCCJ computing resources in a manner consistent with all FCCJ general policies, rules and procedures regarding codes of conduct, academic integrity and the college environment.

Respect the policies established by the administrators of external networks such as those accessible through the Internet. The user shall also respect the policies established by the administrators of computing facilities at FCCJ.

Respect the privacy of electronic mail and other user files transmitted and stored in FCCJ computing facilities or at any other location accessible through a network.

Accept that a userid or program may be terminated, or its priority may be altered if it is consuming excessive system resources, degrading system response or threatening system integrity.

Use only those facilities which are in the public domain, or for which they have obtained explicit authorization, at FCCJ or any other location accessible through FCCJ computing facilities.

Not use the FCCJ computing facilities for conducting private business or for personal financial gain, that is not related to designated college programs or functions.

Not use FCCJ computing facilities for any unauthorized or illegal purpose, such as creation or deliberate introduction of a computer virus, destruction or alteration of data owned by others, destruction or alteration of computing facilities, interference with legitimate access to computing facilities or harassment of users of such facilities at FCCJ or elsewhere, unauthorized disruption of FCCJ computing facilities, attempts to discover or alter passwords or to bypass security systems in FCCJ computing facilities or in any other computing facility.

I understand that violation of these policies may result in temporary or permanent loss of my access to any or all FCCJ computing facilities and other disciplinary actions as appropriate. I also understand that any use of FCCJ facilities is not private and that data and/or transactions may be reviewed by system administrators as part of normal operations and that FCCJ implies no privacy or secrecy for those using its computing facilities.

I further understand that by my acceptance of employment in any capacity with FCCJ and/or registration for classes at FCCJ and/or use of FCCJ computing facilities that I have agreed to and entered into this agreement as it is incorporated into the applications for employment and admission.

Title II of Public Law 101-542 Crime Awareness and Campus Security

Florida Community College at Jacksonville is dedicated to the provision of a safe working and learning environment for all employees and students. In order for these individuals to promptly report criminal actions or other emergencies, FCCJ maintains a 24-hour-a-day security office at each of its facilities. The College also has a special emergency telephone number, ELK-HELP, manned 24 hours a day with direct radio contact to all College security officers.

FCCJ security officers are unarmed and do not have police powers, but they work closely with local law enforcement agencies on follow-up actions or investigations related to criminal activities on campus. In order to facilitate this relationship, all employees and students are encouraged to promptly report all criminal or suspicious activity to the nearest security office.

A special crime prevention unit associated with the security department conducts crime prevention workshops at each FCCJ campus throughout the year. These programs are open to employees and students alike and are free of charge. In support of this crime prevention effort, this same unit maintains points of distribution for appropriate literature at each campus.

Since the College has no recognized fraternities or other off-campus student organizations, there are no records maintained on liquor, drugs or weapons violations by students associated with such organizations.

The College strictly prohibits:

- 1. consumption of alcohol on campus or at College functions,
- **2.** use, manufacture or possession of illegal drugs or narcotics on campus or at College functions, and
- carrying any type of weapon, concealed or otherwise, on campus except as part of the law enforcement training program.

In addition, College policy prohibits smoking in any of its buildings.

Sexual Assault - Sexual assault (rape) is a serious crime which has a major impact on the campus community as well as on the students who are victimized. FCCJ will not tolerate sexual assault in any form, including date and acquaintance sexual assault. Should probable cause be determined that campus regulations prohibiting sexual assault have been violated, disciplinary action will be pursued through the code of student conduct or other appropriate internal processes. Discipline may result in suspension or dismissal from the College. Any student or employee reporting a sexual assault will be treated with respect and sensitivity. Contacts and conversations which transpire pursuant to this procedure will be held in confidence.

Individuals who believe they have been sexually assaulted and wish further information or assistance may contact the campus staff member designated to assist with sexual assaults. Any person wishing to file a complaint may contact a campus security office.

All reported cases will be referred to the crime prevention coordinator, North Campus, Room A-145, telephone 766-6599.

This office will discuss the matter with the student and make referrals as appropriate. The person reporting the incident may request to be kept anonymous. A report will be completed and forwarded to the director of equal access/equal opportunity, Downtown Campus, Room 1097, telephone 633-8250. Situations requiring immediate administrative support will be referred to the campus dean of student affairs.

Employee complaints will be referred to the director of budget and human resources.

Your compliance with the policies outlined above and in helping to prevent crime at FCCJ facilities is appreciated. Only with your help can a safe and secure working and learning environment be provided for all employees and students.

The chart below indicates the number of occurrences for various types of crimes that have occurred on FCCJ facilities over the last six years. These numbers are collegewide and cover all four main campuses, two centers and four support facilities, making FCCJ a very safe place to work and attend classes.
